



DRIVERS' RALLYSports CLUB JAMAICA CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS (2020)

Effective as at January 1, 2020.

These regulations will remain effective for 2 years and are subject to amendment by the DRC Management Committee.

Competitors will be eligible for awards provided they have a current DRC membership and competition license issued by the ASN, the Jamaica Millennium Motoring Club.

Rallysport Champion – Overall 1st

Rookie Rallysport Champion – Overall 1st

Sprint Champion – Overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Class 1st

2WD Sprint Champion – Overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Stages Rally Driver Champion - Overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Stages Rally Co-Driver Champion - Overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Stages Rally 2WD Driver Champion - Overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Stages Rally 2WD Co-Driver Champion - Overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Stages Rally Class Driver Champion - Overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Stages Rally Class Co-Driver Champion - Overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Rallysport Driver Championship

Eligibility

1. Must have competed in the at least one event from both the Sprint and Rally series for the calendar year. Points are earned by Drivers of the following:
 - i. Stages Rallies - Class position
 - ii. Sprints - Class position (JN/JA only)
2. *Bonus points point will be awarded for overall event win of +10 points*

Rookie Rallysport Driver Championship

Eligibility

1. When a person is competing in any rallysport discipline for their first year, he/she is considered a Rookie and may qualify for the Rookie Rallysport Championship as follows:
 - a) If he/ she joins the club before the first half of the championship year, then he/she will only be allowed to compete for the Rookie Rallysport Championship once.
 - b) If the person joined the club after the first half of the year, then he/she will be eligible to compete for the award twice providing he/she does not win the award on the first attempt.
2. Must have competed in the at least one event from both the Sprint and Rally series for the calendar year. Points are earned by Drivers of the following:
 - i. Stages Rallies - Class position
 - ii. Sprints - Class position (JN/JA only)



Sprint Championship

Eligibility

1. The maximum number of points which can be accumulated will come from the total number of sprint events held for the championship year. *Total minimum events shall be three (3) to qualify as a Championship Series.*
2. Points are awarded based on the Championship Run (JN/JA only) of each event. See Schedule 1 for point's allocation.
 - a. *If for any reason there is no championship run points will be awarded based on overall Top 10 finish position.*
 - b. *If a competitor qualifies based on his finish position for the Championship Round but is unable to compete in the round for mechanical reasons he will be awarded 1 point and that position will remain unoccupied in the Championship run.*
3. In the event of a tie for championship position, the following criterion shall be used to break the tie in the order given:
 - i. Most events entered.
 - ii. Most wins.
 - iii. Highest placing.
 - iv. Share Championship.

2WD Sprint Championship

Eligibility

1. The top ten 2WD cars overall in each sprint event (JN/JA only), will earn points *based on Schedule 1* which will go towards the 2WD car sprint championship.
2. In the event of a tie for Championship position, the following criterion shall be used to break the tie in the order given:
 - i. Most events entered.
 - ii. Most wins.
 - iii. Highest placing.
 - iv. Share Championship.

Stages Rally Driver Championship

Eligibility

1. This award can only go to the driver so specified on the entry form; (there can only be one (1) driver per car).
2. The maximum number of points which can be accumulated will come from the total number of stages rallies held for the championship year. *See Schedule 3 for point's allocation.*
3. Points are earned by the following:
 - i. Stages Rally - Overall position

Stages Rally Co-Driver Championship



Eligibility

1. This award can only go to the Co-Driver so specified on the entry form; (there can only be one (1) Co-Driver per car).
2. The maximum number of points that can be accumulated will come from the total number of stages rallies held for the championship year. **See Schedule 3 for point's allocation.**
3. Points are earned by the following:
 - i. Stages Rally - Overall position

Stages Rally 2WD Driver Championship

Eligibility

1. This award can only go to the driver so specified on the entry form; (there can only be one (1) driver per car).
2. The maximum number of points that can be accumulated will come from the total number of stages rallies held for the championship year. *See Schedule 4 for point's allocation.*
3. **The top five (5) highest placed overall 2WD cars** in the following events earn driver's points:
 - i. Stages Rally - Overall position

Stages Rally 2WD Co-Driver Championship

Eligibility

4. This award can only go to the Co-Driver so specified on the entry form; (there can only be one (1) Co-Driver per car).
5. The maximum number of points which can be accumulated will come from the total number of stages rallies held for the championship year. *See Schedule 4 for point's allocation.*
6. **The top five (5) highest placed overall 2WD cars** in the following events earn Co-Driver's points:
 - i. Stages Rally - Overall position

Stages Rally Class Driver & Co-Driver Championship

Eligibility

4. This award can only go to the driver or co-driver so specified on the entry form; (there can only be one (1) driver/co-driver per car).
5. The maximum number of points which can be accumulated will come from the total number of stages rallies held for the championship year. **See Schedule 3 for point's allocation.**
6. Points are earned by the following:
 - ii. Stages Rally - Class finish position



Points and Awards (applicable for Sprints & Rallies)

a) Only DRC members shall qualify for points, regardless of the status of the event. Awards shall be given to non-members and invited guests in the same manner as DRC members.

b) Awards shall be presented as follows:

- i) 1 to 3 cars in class - 1st place only.
- ii) 4 to 6 cars in class - 1st & 2nd place only.
- iii) 7+ cars in class - 1st, 2nd & 3rd place.
- v) Fastest overall - 1st place only. (Sprints) 1st, 2nd, 3rd (Stages Rallies)
- v) Fastest 2WD - 1st place only (Sprints); 1st, 2nd, 3rd (Stages Rallies)
