Championship scores regulated by DRC Championship Regulations 2020. This event is open to all members in good standing of the JMMC and its affiliate clubs.

Type of event: Asphalt Sprint

Course Length: *Approximately* 1.4km. 2 laps for regular runs, 1 lap Championship run. **Technical Inspection:** 7:30a.m. – 8:30a.m.

All vehicles shall comply with the Mandatory Safety Requirements as specified in Section 6.1.1 of the JMMC Regulations. Mandatory Drivers equipment MUST be presented at Technical Inspection Log Books must be presented at scrutineering. Note: Approved flame-resistant overalls, helmets and Front Head Restraint (FHR) per

2024 JMMC Safety Regulations are mandatory for all competitors.

Class Rules: Per the 2018 JMMC Technical Regulations with special attention to: JN,

JA & JC to be governed by engine CC ratings, weight of vehicle, Rim and Tyre size.

Classes:

- JA8 (4WD) 2000cc x 1.7 / 3400cc x .75 = 2550 lbs. Min weight. (9-inch rim Max)
- JA2 (2WD) 0-1600cc x 1.17 = Min weight (8-inch rim max)
- JA3 (2WD) 1601-2000cc x 1.02 = min weight (9-inch rim max)
- JA4 (2WD) Over 2000cc x.81 = Min weight (9-inch rim max)

NOTE: all JA classes with forced induction must be fitted with a 34mm restrictor as per JMMC Regs.

- JC1 (2wd) 0-2000cc Naturally Aspirated to include "cross breed" engines.
- JC2 (2wd) 2001cc and over- Non restricted forced induction and naturally aspirated
- JC3 (4wd) 3000cc and over Non restricted forced induction.

NOTE: All classes are subjected to a MANDATORY tyre rule of using DOT tyres. Only 6 (six) tyres will be allowed for the event. An additional 2 extra will be allowed to facilitate punctures/tyre damage (Official must give go ahead to make change). Rain tyres are free. All classes will be able to win overall standings for the event; the 10 fastest times of the day will qualify for the Final 3 lapper run.





Drivers Meeting: 9:00 am, at the Official's tent.

Trophies: Awards will be given as per DRC Championship Regulations

License requirement: ALL DRIVERS must have a minimum JMMC National A Competition Driver's License (National B for Rookies ONLY) to participate in the event. JMMC 2024 Competition License MUST be presented at Registration and Scrutineering.

Entries Open: Saturday March 1st, 2025

Entries Close: Sunday March 16th, 2025 8:00am

Entry Fees: \$12,000.00 Must be paid on the morning of the event.

Results: Provisional Results will be posted to the Officials Notice Board within one (1) hour of the end of the Championship Run. Official Final Results shall be sent via email on Monday March 17th, 2025.
