TRANSPONDERS

The MYLAPS Transponder is included in your package. Transponders may be collected **Sunday April 20 from 9am to Sunday April 21 8am**. All competitors who hold a transponder from the JRDC are required to return them to the Timekeeping area by the end of Race Day. **Failure to do so, will result in a charge of J\$10,000** along with the returned transponder, payable to the JRDC. Competitors are liable for any damage incurred to the transponder whilst in their possession.

DESIGNATED PARKING AREA

On Qualifying Day and Race Day all vehicles and personnel are required to have on the necessary credentials to be in the paddock area. NO PARKING OF SERVICE VEHICLES / TRAILERS / WRECKERS WILL BE ALLOWED WITHIN THE PADDOCK AREA





Competitor parking and service vehicle parking are in the usual areas:

- Competitor parking in the general parking areas external to the main gate
- Service vehicles to be parked in the infield area adjacent to the paddock access gate/tower
- Trailers may be parked on the infield of Corner 3

LICENSES

A Minimum JMMC 2025 National B competition license for rookies and MINIMUM 2025 National A competition license for all other local competitors. All overseas competitors MUST possess a 2025 Competition license issued by their country's ASN and present a letter from their country of residence's ASN granting them permission to compete.

Rookie drivers shall place a triangle with a sharply contrasting background (no less than ½" thick lines) on the rear of their cars, in a prominent position. **Drivers who have never completed 3 races in one calendar year shall be considered rookies**.

COMPETITORS BRIEFING

Mandatory Competitors Briefing at the track, Monday April 21, 2025 @ 8:30 am ground level at the pit lane exit below the Timing Area. Failure by the competitor or his / her representative to attend the mandatory Competitors meeting and sign the attendance sheet shall result in the deduction of one (1) Championship Point.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION

Technical Inspection commences on Sunday April 20, 2025 at 8:00am

The Scrutineer shall check for mandatory safety equipment, vehicle safety, mechanical compliance to classifications (where possible). VEHICLES ARE REQUIRED TO PASS SCRUTINEERING FOR ENTRY ON TRACK FOR ALL SESSIONS: warm up, qualifying, racing. Competitors completing a track lap without passing the scrutineer inspection may be subject to sanctions.

Post-race and qualifying technical inspection shall take place immediately after each session. All cars in ALL CLASSES (except SS) shall proceed DIRECTLY to the scale area to be checked for the necessary decals and logos, and in some cases to be weighed. Failure to do so may result in disqualification, at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. The onus is on the competitor to present his car promptly for inspection and weighing. A crewmember from each team should remain with the car while it is in the scrutineering / scale area.

Competitors are required to gueue for the Inspection Area on the left side of the pit lane.

VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION MARKS

Each vehicle is-to carry identification numbers, class classifications, or other required marks as follows:





- Classification decals should be prominently displayed on the first 1/3 of the front doors on both sides of the vehicle or the area that closest approximates it when the vehicle is viewed in profile.
- Font characters for race numbers should be at least six (6) inches high and three (3) inches wide.
- The text of all decals should have a distinctly contrasting background.
- SS cars may place decals on the front or rear side [window] glass instead of the body panels. All
 other decal specifications apply.

OFFICIAL SCALES

The Official Scales shall be available to all competitors during the event except for when post-race technical inspection is being conducted. **THE ONUS IS ON THE COMPETITORS TO HAVE THEIR CARS AT THE PROPER WEIGHT.** Failure to verify actual car weight may be subject to penalty including potential disqualification.

OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARDS

Four (4) locations are provided at the track. The Official Notice Board is located between Bays 15 & 16 in the paddock area. The three (3) other Notice Boards are located at Area Bay 30; in the paddock between Bays 6 & 7; and under a tent area between Bays 11 & 12.

RESULTS

The Provisional Results will be posted <u>15 minutes after each race</u> and in the absence of any inquiries, complaints, protests or technical inspections pending, will become final after the expiration of **60 minutes**. Competitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to check the Official Notice Boards for the results of their races, and bring any inquiries, complaints or protests arising from the race itself to the attention of the Clerk of the Course, within the time specified above.

The bracket times for bracket classes (Super Street and Improved Production) for Dover Raceway will be:

Break Out Rules

"Breakout" rules are in effect. Any breakout (BO) by a competitor in any bracket class will result in:

- a. Exclusion from the finishing results of that race and
- b. Relegation to the back of the grid for the immediate next race at the same event (this penalty does not carry forward to the next race meet). Where there are multiple Breakouts for a race, the relegation to the back of the next grid will be determined by order of least break out (least BO to most).

A Break Out during the qualifying session is penalized by a Pit Lane start for Race 1.

IP Amended Rule

Dry Sumping of engines is permitted.

MP Amended Rule

All 4WD cars competing in MP4 are required to run 100 Treadwear Tires.

AWARDS & CHAMPIONSHIPS

Trophies shall be awarded to the 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place finishers in each class. To be considered a finisher, a competitor must complete 75% of the race distance.

Championship points will be awarded for 1st through 6th place, for finishers in each class as follows:

2nd 7

3rd 5

4th 3

Two (2) Championship points are awarded to each competitor for qualifying on pole position in his/her class.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Competitors and crew members shall conduct themselves to the highest standards of behavior and sportsmanship, particularly in relation to other competitors, officials, sponsors and their products, in a manner that shall not be prejudicial to the reputation of the JMMC, JRDC or to motorsports in general. Failure to do so may result in penalties which, if imposed, are not subject to appeal. Abuse of Marshalls will not be tolerated.

The Competitor shall be responsible for all acts or omissions on the part of any person providing a service in connection with a Competition or Championship on their behalf, including their employees & crew, service providers and any person the Competitor has allowed access to the Reserved Areas.

All Competitors are reminded that the JRDC General Regulations Article 13, Code of Driving Conduct are in effect.

Each incident involving contact shall be reviewed by Stewards. Competitors involved in such incidents shall report to Clerk of the Course for an interview (and possible further investigations) within 10 minutes after the end of the race in question.





Any SS driver involved in **any incident of contact with another car** shall exit the track into the Pit Lane at the very next opportunity and report to SS Coordinator or Clerk of the Course.

Additionally, all drivers are bound by the 2024 JMMC Code Of Driving Conduct On Circuits.

Safety Signaling System

This event shall utilize the e-flag Racer Safety Signaling System for all Modified Production (MP) and Thundersport (TS) classes.

MP and TS Drivers must download and install the 'e-flag Racer' app from the Play Store (Android) or App Store (iPhone). The app may be installed on a cell phone or tablet. Once installed, driver's must inform Event Timing so they may be registered.

Drivers in MS and TS must ensure that their cell phone or tablet is securely mounted in their race cars, within the driver's field of vision.
