Scrutineering: 8:30a.m. – 9:30a.m. All vehicles shall comply with the Mandatory Safety Requirements as specified in Section 6.1.1 of the JMMC Regulations. Mandatory Drivers equipment MUST be presented at Technical Inspection *Log Books (Where available) are to be presented at scrutineering. FIA Standard Approved fire-retardant race suits and helmets are mandatory for all competitors.*

ENTRIES

Closing Date for Entries

Competitors wishing to take part in the event must submit their entry form duly completed by 6:00p.m Wednesday June 18, 2025.

Entry Procedure

Those wishing to take part in the Rally must register and fill in the electronic entry form which will be posted via DRCJA Events WhatsApp group before the closing date for entries. Entry fee payment will be collected at registration on Sunday June 22, 2025 or alternately by means so communicated by the event organizer to competitors upon completion of entry form.

Number of Entrants Accepted (Cars & Classes)

The organizers will need a minimum of 10 entries to host this event.

Late entries (providing the minimum quota is met) will be accepted up to 9am on Sunday June 22, 2025.

Entry Fee: J\$25,000.00

Payment of Entry Fees

Payments must be made to the Drivers Rallysport Club (Jamaica) Limited – CASH PAYMENT ONLY.

Entry fee payment will be collected at registration on Sunday June 22, 2025 or alternately by means so communicated by the event organizer to competitors upon completion of entry form.

Stage Recce: The stages will be off limits to competitors from May 22, 2025 until the recce days of June 20 & 21, 2025. Competitors can use either of these 2 days to traverse the stages and make pace notes between 0800 hrs and 1700 hrs.

Under no circumstances must any rally car be seen on any stage.

Competitors are not to exceed 30mph on stages. Any competitors found exceeding this limit can face disciplinary actions. Penalties could include exclusion from the Rally



Kindly note these roads will have other users and other competitors. Expect two-way traffic.

Please remember that the properties are working premises and employees will be carrying out their normal work procedures so exercise due diligence and care when traversing the stages for pace noting.

Scrutineering:

Cars will be inspected for FULL safety compliance and roadworthiness (lights, brakes, etc.). Competitors must present competitors' safety equipment, valid drivers and competition licenses, and Island Traffic Authority compliance. Failure to pass Technical Inspection will result in entrants not being allowed to start the Rally.

All competing vehicles must comply with the JMMC Safety Regulations concerning their classifications and safety requirements. Classes are as per JMMC Regulations. Use of competitor safety gear - Racing suit & helmet, is mandatory for the duration of the event.

The decision of the Chief scrutineer is final and not subject to protest.

Results: Provisional Results will be made available at the Officials Notice Board within 30 minutes after the end of the rally. Final Results shall be posted via DRCJA Events WhatsApp Group to all competitors on Sunday June 22, 2025.

Timing: Targa Card.

Official Notice Board: At the Officials Tent in the Service Park

ALL JA8 and JN8 competitors MUST have the required JMMC restrictor seal in place. Competitors without or whose access is restricted must make arrangements to fit seals prior to the event.

Special Note: Where an electronic timing system is being used be advised that "The Electronic timing equipment, once employed, will be the sole arbiter of a pick start; the penalty will be as per JMMC rally rules, 1 Minute."
